Theater Camp

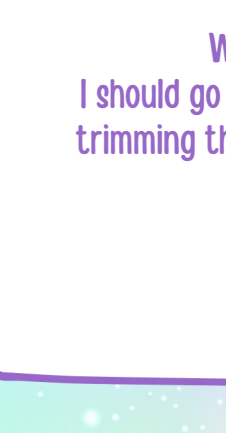
All About It
